User Guide

The Mekong Club Transparency in Supply Chains (TISC) tool provides an overview of the key considerations in preparing and publishing transparency in supply chain statements. It aims to assist companies to address their obligations for reporting under any of the current enacted laws, which require public statements to be made, in a comprehensive and compliant manner.

The TISC tool consists of:

1. A Legislation at a Glance summary of the California Transparency in Supply Chains act, the U.K. Modern Slavery Act, the France Duty of Vigilance, and the Australia Modern Slavery Act and
2. Four interactive flowcharts providing detailed information for each of the relevant laws.

From 31 March 2016, any company that meets all three conditions below in a financial year:

1. Commercial organisation that supplies goods or services including a trade or profession;
2. Carries on business or part of a business (even if its main function is non-commercial) in any part of the United Kingdom; and
3. Has total annual turnover of not less than GBP36 million.

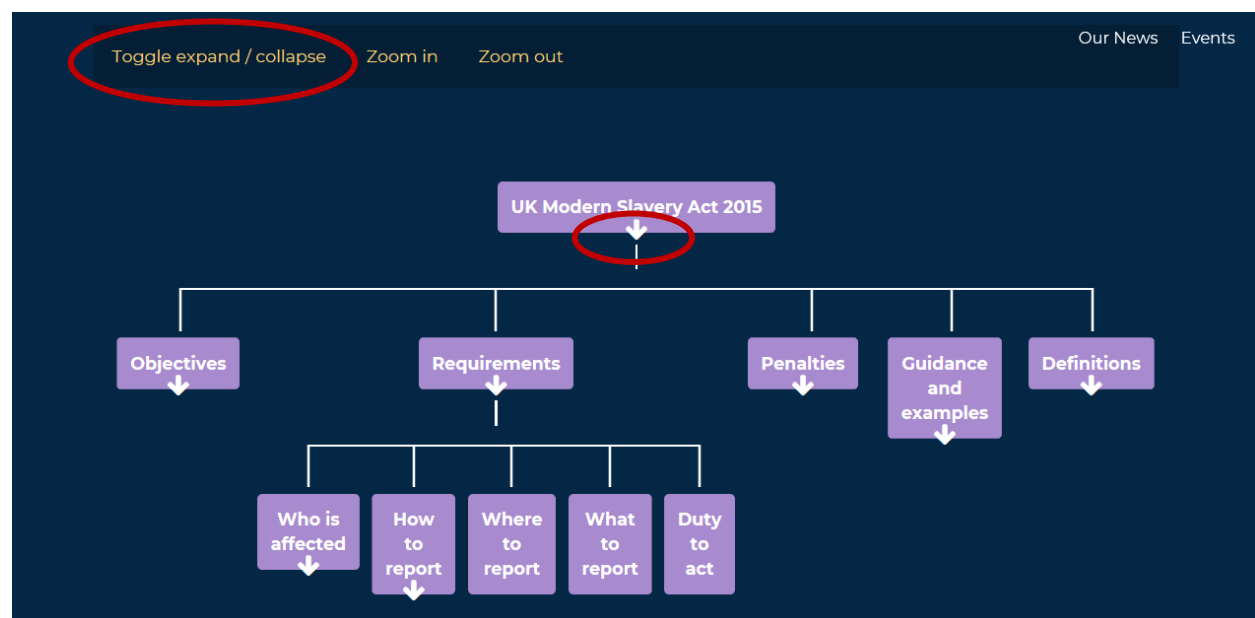

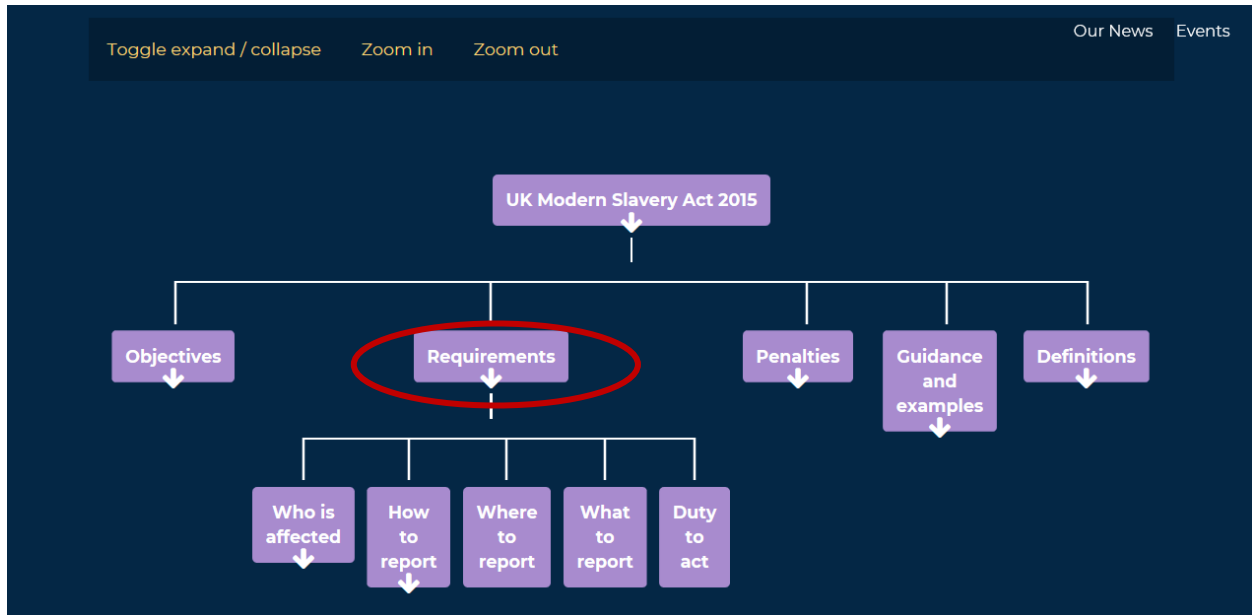
